# At the crossroads of two EU strategies

## Data Strategy



Establish a single market for data  
Enable data sharing and  
establish fair and clear rules on  
data use and access.

## Sustainable and smart mobility strategy



Ensure that the EU transport sector  
is fit for a clean, digital and modern  
economy

→ A **common European mobility data space**  
facilitating access, pooling and sharing of data from existing  
and future transport and mobility data sources

# Common European data spaces

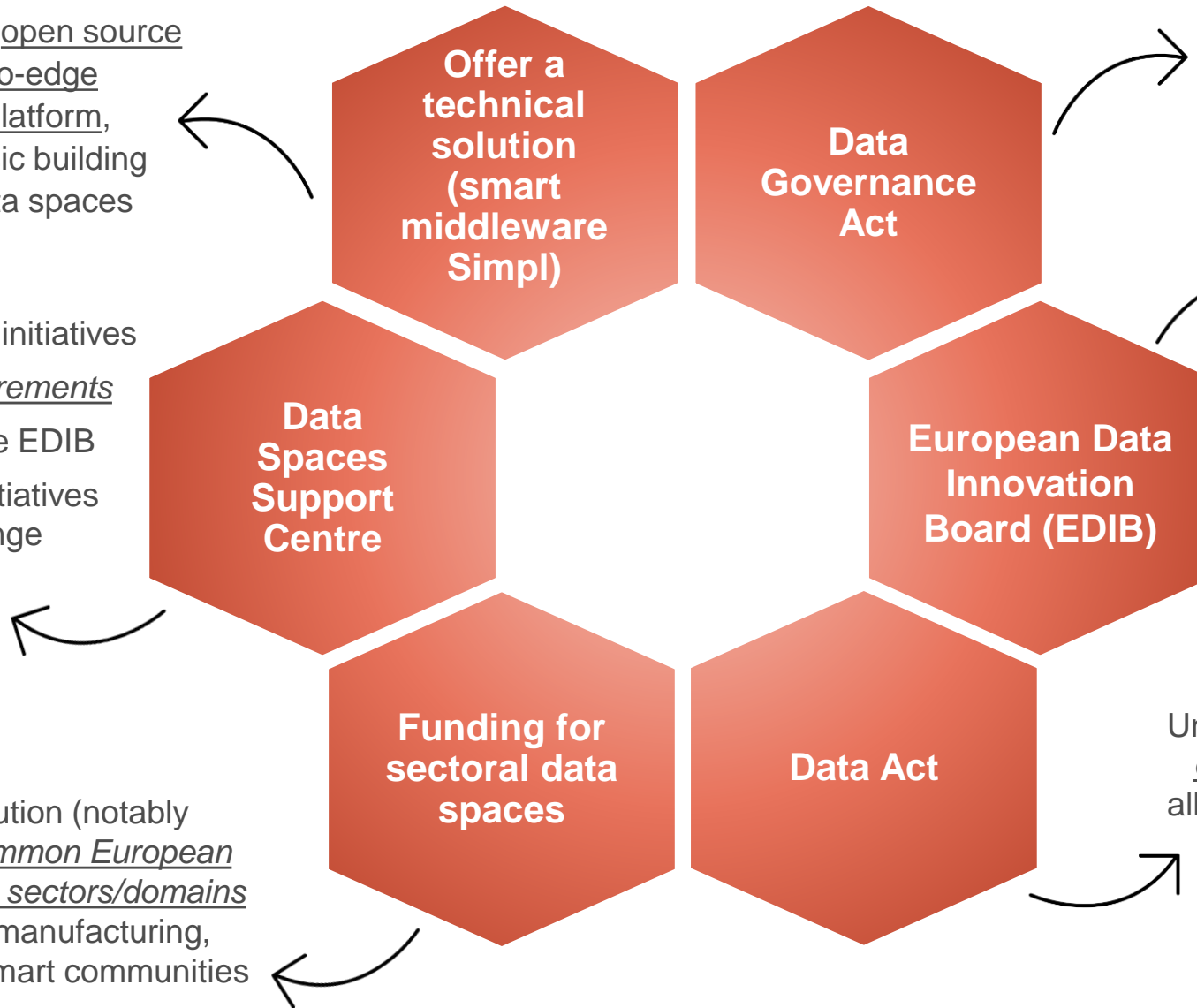
- ✓ **Data space:** decentralised infrastructure enabling data sharing between parties within a data ecosystem, based on a common governance framework.
  - ✓ **Secure and trustworthy:** Participants in data spaces can access and share data in a secure, trusted, easy and unified way.
  - ✓ **Data sovereignty:** Data holders can control who accesses their data, for what purpose and under which conditions.
  - ✓ **Compliant with applicable EU legislation,** both sectoral and cross-sectoral.
- Deployment in key sectors: health, manufacturing, agriculture, **mobility**, Green Deal (including smart cities and communities), energy, tourism, etc.

# The EC's role in supporting the creation of data spaces

Procuring an open source smart cloud-to-edge middleware platform, providing basic building blocks for data spaces

- EU project to
- coordinate data space initiatives
  - Identify common requirements
  - Support the work of the EDIB
  - Support data space initiatives and knowledge exchange

EU financial contribution (notably DIGITAL) to deploy common European data spaces in strategic sectors/domains e.g. mobility, energy, manufacturing, tourism Green Deal & smart communities



Increase trust in data sharing (neutral data intermediaries, i.e., the orchestrators of the data spaces)

Support the Commission in:

- Issuing guidelines to facilitate the development of the common European data spaces
- Identifying the relevant standards and interoperability requirements for cross-sector data sharing

Unlock the potential of the EU's industrial data (IoT data), ensure fairness in the allocation of data value among the actors of the data economy
