At the crossroads of two EU strategies

Data Strategy



Establish a single market for data Enable data sharing and establish fair and clear rules on data use and access.

Sustainable and smart mobility strategy



Ensure that the EU transport sector is fit for a clean, digital and modern economy

→ A common European mobility data space

facilitating access, pooling and sharing of data from existing and future transport and mobility data sources

Common European data spaces

- ✓ Data space: decentralised infrastructure enabling data sharing between parties within a data ecosystem, based on a common governance framework.
- ✓ Secure and trustworthy: Participants in data spaces can access and share data in a secure, trusted, easy and unified way.
- ✓ Data sovereignty: Data holders can control who accesses their data, for what purpose and under which conditions.
- ✓ Compliant with applicable EU legislation, both sectoral and cross-sectoral.
- → Deployment in key sectors: health, manufacturing, agriculture, **mobility**, Green Deal (including smart cities and communities), energy, tourism, etc.



The EC's role in supporting the creation of data spaces

Procuring an open source smart cloud-to-edge middleware platform, providing basic building blocks for data spaces

Offer a technical solution (smart middleware Simpl)

Data Governance Act Increase <u>trust</u> in data sharing (neutral data intermediaries, i.e., the orchestrators of the data spaces)

EU project to

- <u>coordinate</u> data space initiatives
- Identify <u>common requirements</u>
- Support the work of the EDIB
- Support data space initiatives and knowledge exchange

European Data Innovation Board (EDIB) Support the Commission in:

- Issuing guidelines to facilitate the development of the common European data spaces
- Identifying the relevant standards and interoperability requirements for <u>cross-sector</u> <u>data sharing</u>

EU financial contribution (notably DIGITAL) to <u>deploy common European</u> <u>data spaces in strategic sectors/domains</u> e.g. mobility, energy, manufacturing, tourism Green Deal & smart communities

Funding for sectoral data spaces

Data Act

Unlock the potential of the EU's <u>industrial</u> <u>data</u> (IoT data), ensure <u>fairness</u> in the allocation of data value among the actors of the data economy
