The crisis facing transportation

- Regional mobility crisis, Declining quality of transportation services
- Stagnant digitalization/mobility revolution
- > Labor shortage in logistics
- Safety and Security (reducing disasters, deterioration, and accidents)
- Delays in global warming countermeasures in the transportation sector

Three Basic Policies

- Maintaining and securing transportation essential to daily life so that everyone can move more comfortably and easily
- Strengthening highly functional and highly productive transportation networks and systems that support Japan's economic growth
- ◆ Realizing sustainable and green transportation that thoroughly ensures safety and security during abnormal times such as disasters, epidemics, and accidents
