DATA SHARING

A key objective for the FAME project is to increase data sharing in the CCAM community, and on the Knowledge Base (follow [this link](#)) there is an entire section dedicated to this topic.

A proposed facilitator is to use the concept of federated data sharing, with the practical implementation in a so-called data space. The idea is to have small components interfacing larger datasets. This means that the complete dataset is not shared, but it is the sum of agreed-upon computations. The data provider is thus in complete control of which actor has access to what data.

The available datasets in the data space are published in a [metadata catalogue](#), but to take benefit of the data, common principles for data description and common formats are recommended.

FAME will demonstrate data space capabilities in a **CCAM Test Data Space**. To set the first requirements and concepts, the Data Sharing Framework has been thoroughly updated, adding federated data sharing

as a key concept. The updates span all chapters, adding relevant content and updating sections outdated by the development in data exchange, standards and legal developments.

The **CCAM Data Sharing Framework Version 2** was recently published and it is available here. Access the online reader-friendly format below or [download the document](#).

It should be noted that the complete data sharing section has been updated, including a new data catalogue on datasets published for automated driving research. Additional datasets will be published shortly.

The **CCAM Data Sharing Framework v2** will have a second update, taking into account the lessons learnt in the development of the Test data space demonstrator (spring 2025).
